- In 2017, the per capita income for an IHMS client was \$903.39 per month—
- Over 50% of the homes we work on have a value of less than \$11,000 and were built prior to 1929.

In the past 5 years alone, Interfaith's crew workers have provided 5,071 units of service for 3,079 jobs done for low-income homeowners. We continue to serve our community's most disadvantaged families.

Note: **100%** of Interfaith's clients are at, or below, 50% of the area's *median* income, the standard applied by the Department of Housing and Urban Development for the recipients of Community Development Block Grant-funded programs.
